














Lives affected by COVID-19 in the USA






























Surges in COVID-19 deaths and surges in orphanhood: Mar 1 – Dec 30, 2020, vs Jan 1 – May 31, 2021

















"God is a Father to the Fatherless and Sets the Lonely in Families" -- Brazil, India, USA, Ukraine





















Our updated estimates using new available data show that a minimum of 5 million children have experienced death of a mother, a father, or a grandparent caregiver. As big as these numbers are, they are only global minimum estimates.

This means over the past 5 months, 1 child has been affected every 6 seconds.

Addressing the loss these children have experienced - and continue to experience, must be a top priority for emergency response both now and in the future.
