3 After his suffering, he presented himself to them and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. and whoever shuns evil becomes a prey. The Lord looked and was displeased that there was no justice. 16 He saw that there was no one, he was appalled that there was no one to intervene; so his own arm achieved salvation for him, and his own righteousness sustained him. He put on righteousness as his breastplate, and the helmet of salvation on his head; he put on the garments of vengeance and wrapped himself in zeal as in a cloak.

18 According to what they have done, so will he repay wrath to his enemies and retribution to his foes; he will repay the islands their due. 19 From the west, people will fear the name of the Lord, and from the rising of the sun, they will revere his glory. **For he will come like a pent-up flood that the breath of the Lord drives along.** 20 "The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who repent of their sins," declares the Lord.
