JOSHUA 4:1-7

When the whole nation had finished crossing the Jordan, the Lord said to Joshua, 2 "Choose twelve men from among the people, one from each tribe, 3 and tell them to take up twelve stones from the middle of the Jordan, from right where the priests are standing, and carry them over with you and put them down at the place where you stay tonight." 4 So Joshua called together the twelve men he had appointed from the Israelites, one from each tribe, 5 and said to them, "Go over before the

ark of the Lord your God into the middle of the Jordan. Each of you is to take up a stone on his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the Israelites, 6 to serve as a sign among you. In the future, when your children ask you, 'What do these stones mean?' 7 tell them that the flow of the Jordan was cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it crossed the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. These stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever."

PSALM 143:5

PSALM 145:5

1 SAMUEL 17:33-37

33 Saul replied, "You are not able to go out against this Philistine and fight him; you are only a young man, and he has been a warrior from his youth." 34 But David said to Saul, "Your servant has been keeping his father's sheep. **When a lion or a bear came** and carried off a sheep from the flock, 35 I went after it, struck it and rescued the sheep from its mouth. When it turned on me, I seized it by its hair, struck it and killed it.





1 SAMUEL 17:33-37

36 Your servant has killed both the lion and the bear; this uncircumcised Philistine will be like one of them, because he has defied the armies of the living God. 37 The Lord who rescued me from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear will rescue me from the hand of this Philistine." . . . 40 Then he took his staff in his hand, **chose five smooth stones** from the stream, put them in the pouch of his shepherd's bag and, with his sling in his hand, approached the Philistine.





A WARNING FROM PSALMS





PSALM 78:1-7

1 My people, hear my teaching; listen to the words of my mouth. 2 I will open my mouth with a parable; I will utter hidden things, things from of old—3 things we have heard and known, things our ancestors have told us. 4 We will not hide them from their descendants; we will tell the next generation the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, his power, and the wonders he has done.





PSALM 78:1-7

5 He decreed statutes for Jacob and established the law in Israel, which **he commanded our ancestors to teach their children**, 6 so the next generation even the children yet to be born, and **they in turn would tell their children**.

7 Then they would **put their trust in God** and would **not forget his deeds** but would **keep his commands**.





PUT THEIR TRUST IN GOD PSALM 78:19-22

19 Yes, they **spoke against God**: They said, "**Can God** prepare a table in the wilderness? 20 Behold, He struck the rock, So that the waters gushed out, And the streams overflowed. **Can He** give bread also? Can He provide meat for His people?" 21 Therefore the Lord heard this and was furious; So a fire was kindled against Jacob, And anger also came up against Israel, 22 Because **they did not believe in God**, And **did not trust in His salvation**.





NOT FORGET HIS DEEDS PSALM 78:1-7

How often they provoked Him in the wilderness, And grieved Him in the desert! 41 Yes, again and again **they tempted God**, And **limited the Holy One of Israel**. 42 They **did not remember His power**: The day when He redeemed them from the enemy, 43 When He worked His signs in Egypt, And His wonders in the field of Zoan;
