A mandate to all

1 Peter 4:10 (NIV) Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

A renewed mind

Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God---this is your true and proper worship. 2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is---his good, pleasing and perfect will.

The internal chorus of dissent

- I sense worldly thinking when God speaks and things internally disagree - an internal chorus of dissent
- 2 Corinthians 10:15 as your **faith** continues to grow,
- 2 Thessalonians 1:3 your **faith** is growing more and more
- Colossians 1:10 growing in the **knowledge** of God,
- 1 Peter 2:2 grow up in your **salvation**,
- 2 Peter 3:18 But grow in the **grace** and **knowledge** of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

A renewed mind

Nehemiah 8:9 Then Nehemiah the governor, Ezra the priest and teacher of the Law, and the Levites who were instructing the people said to them all, “This day is holy to the Lord your God. Do not mourn or weep.” For all the people had been weeping as they listened to the words of the Law. 10 Nehemiah said, “Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, **for the joy of the Lord is your strength.**” 11 The Levites calmed all the people, saying, “Be still, for this is a holy day. Do not grieve.”

Psalm 21:1 The king rejoices in your strength, Lord. How great is his joy in the victories you give! 2 You have granted him his heart's desire and have not withheld the request of his lips.

John 16:23 In that day you will no longer ask me anything. Very truly I tell you, my Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. 24 Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.
