

MAY 25TH

- I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people, to restore the land and to reassign its desolate inheritances,' Isaiah 49:8-9 (NIV)
- As God's co-workers we urge you not to receive God's grace in vain. 2 For he says, "In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you." I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation. - 2 Corinthians 6:1-3 (NIV)

- 8 Ask me, and I will make the nations your inheritance, the ends of the earth your possession. - Psalm 2:7-8 (NIV)
- The land was assigned by lot as inheritance in the Presence of the Lord
- The inheritance was freely given but they had to fight for it - the Lord promised to drive the peoples who lived there out
- Little by little they would be driven out in front of His people

JUNE 1ST

- We learned that Israel's physical taking of the promised land is a type for us to take our inheritance - first the natural and then the spiritual
- 3 I will give you every place where you set your foot as I promised Moses.
- 5 I will never leave you or forsake you . . 9 the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go
- 6 be strong and courageous . . 7 be strong and very courageous . . be strong and courageous

JUNE 1ST continued

- Keep God's word on your lips to remind you
- Those who already have breakthrough cross over first to help the rest fight for theirs

JUNE 8TH

- Do whatever Jesus tells you
- Lean forward go for it
- Take courage
- expect great things

JUNE 15TH

- Mount Gerizim and Mount Ebal -Deuteronomy 27:11-26
- 28 Now you, brothers and sisters, like Isaac, are children of promise. 30 But what does Scripture say? "Get rid of the slave woman and her son, for the slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with the free woman's son." 31 Therefore, brothers and sisters, we are not children of the slave woman, but of the free woman. Galatians 4:21-31 (NIV) from Genesis 21:10

JUNE 15TH continued

- 4 the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, Romans 8:4 (NIV)
- 20 For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 1:20 (NIV)

JUNE 22ND

- Find your assigned space in the kingdom
- Get your mind straight
- 13 Therefore, with minds that are alert and fully sober, set your hope on the grace to be brought to you when Jesus Christ is revealed at his coming. 1 Pet 1:13 [NIV]
- Action unlocks inheritance so step out in faith and start doing something

JUNE 29TH

- "The single most effective evangelistic methodology under heaven is planting new churches." -C. Peter Wagner
- Why we build churches
 - 1. Its Biblical -in orthodoxy and ortho praxis
 - 2. It enforces Jesus dominion (inheritance)
 - 3. It engages people, demands growth from them and calls for sacrifice

JUNE 29TH continued

- 4. New church plants are the most effective way to reach new converts, new residents, and to impact new people groups
- 5. We have a God-given clarity on the gospel message and a mature response to the Holy Spirit
- There are 4 ways everyone can be involved
- Pray
- Pay
- Partner
- Preach

JULY 6TH

- We are told to be: strong and courageous
- We are forbidden to be: afraid and discouraged
- Caleb's example shows us to be wholehearted
- Joshua's example teaches us to keep demonstrable testimonies
- Remember God qualified you to share this inheritance where He justifies someone who can lay accusation?

JULY 13TH

- 12 What shall I return to the Lord for all his goodness to me? 13 I will lift up the cup of salvation and call on the name of the Lord -Psalm 116:12-13
- 1. Drink deep the cup of salvation
- 2. Share the cup with others
 - Personally
 - in community
 - In church

JULY 20TH

- We seemed like grasshoppers in our own eyes, and we looked the same to them." -Numbers 13:33
- 1. Know what God said so you can repeat it
- 2. Deny other opinions so they do not contaminate you
- 3. Go and tell the world so that they can see truth

13 The king of the Ammonites answered Jephthah's messengers, "When Israel came up out of Egypt, they took away my land from the Arnon to the Jabbok, all the way to the Jordan. Now give it back peaceably." 14 Jephthah sent back messengers to the Ammonite king. 15 saying: "This is what Jephthah says: Israel did not take the land of Moab or the land of the Ammonites. 16 But when they came up out of Egypt, Israel went through the wilderness to the Red Sea[a] and on to Kadesh. 17 Then Israel sent messengers to the king of Edom, saying, 'Give us permission to go through your country,' but the king of Edom would not listen. They sent

also to the king of Moab, and he refused. So Israel stayed at Kadesh. 18 "Next they traveled through the wilderness, skirted the lands of Edom and Moab, passed along the eastern side of the country of Moab, and camped on the other side of the Arnon. They did not enter the territory of Moab, for the Arnon was its border. 19 "Then Israel sent messengers to Sihon king of the Amorites, who ruled in Heshbon, and said to him, 'Let us pass through your country to our own place.' 20 Sihon, however, did not trust Israel to pass through his territory. He mustered all his troops and encamped at Jahaz and fought with Israel. 21 "Then the Lord, the

God of Israel, gave Sihon and his whole army into Israel's hands, and they defeated them. Israel took over all the land of the Amorites who lived in that country, 22 capturing all of it from the Arnon to the Jabbok and from the desert to the Jordan. 23 "Now since the Lord, the God of Israel, has driven the Amorites out before his people Israel, what right have you to take it over? 24 Will you not take what your god Chemosh gives you? Likewise, whatever the Lord our God has given us, we will possess.
