- Paul and Silas in prison, in stocks, in the dungeon, backs whipped are singing praises

1. Sacrifices of Praise

4 For the Lord takes delight in his people; he crowns the humble with victory. 5 Let his faithful people rejoice in this honor and sing for joy on their beds. 6 May the praise of God be in their mouths and a double-edged sword in their hands, 7 to inflict vengeance on the nations and punishment on the peoples, 8 to bind their kings with fetters, their nobles with shackles of iron, 9 to carry out the sentence written against them— this is the glory of all his faithful people.

3. Deny the lie

19 No one stops to think, no one has the knowledge or understanding to say,"Half of it I used for fuel; I even baked bread over its coals, I roasted meat and I ate. Shall I make a detestable thing from what is left? Shall I bow down to a block of wood?" 20 Such a person feeds on ashes; a deluded heart misleads him; he cannot save himself, or say, "Is not this thing in my right hand a lie?"

3. Deny the lie - Thoughts

- Every now and then I have to come to a place where I call the lie a lie that is a lie and it must come out of my mouth loudly
- How can you tell if the enemies lying to you? if his lips are moving, if you're hearing anything he's saying
- Anything that seeks to get you back to earning your salvation by your own efforts, anything that seeks to deny the finished work of Jesus on your behalf and that puts you back as though, salvation, cleansing, favor with God, fulness is yet to be attained

4. Amen's of agreement

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.

4. Amen's of agreement - Thoughts

- What are you amen-ing
- No-one can make you inferior without your consent Eleanor
 Rooseveldt AND I DO NOT CONSENT
- Watch for definitions I missed it there but am not so defined
- Keys of the kingdom if it has been unlocked to you in the atonement it can be unlocked by you on the earth by your amen

5. Deliberate sowing

20 From the fruit of their mouth a person's stomach is filled; with the harvest of their lips they are satisfied. 21 The tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.

A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. 2 The tongue of the wise adorns knowledge, but the mouth of the fool gushes folly.
