



- in memory, a tendency to distort recalled events to make them fit one's expectations
- is a form of reactivity in which a researcher's cognitive bias causes them to subconsciously influence the participants of an experiment. It is typically controlled using a double-blind experimental design.

Because of Imputation . . .

The word "Impute" is a book-keeping term. It means to set down or to charge to one's account. Theologically it is "That act by which God charges or reckons His righteousness to our account"


In Romans chapter 4 the Greek word "Logizomai" is used 11 times.

It is translated "**counted**" (v3,5), "**reckoned**" (v4,9,10), and **imputed**" (v6,8,11,22,23,24)

• When Jesus went to Calvary, the sin of the whole human race was "imputed" to His account. All of our liabilities were transferred to Him so that by His death He was "reckoned" among the transgressors. (Luke 22:37)

• The righteousness of Christ is now "imputed" to those who believe. The assets of Christ are now transferred to us. Our account has been credited with the merits of Jesus.


