10 intriguing facts about the Kingdom

Pursue Understanding

The Greek word for kingdom is "basileia" and means a realm or a region governed. The word "kingdom" is made up of the noun "king", and the suffix "dom". A kingdom is the domain over which a king exercises authority and rule and includes the people within that domain.

Manage Expectation

In Hebrew thought the kingdom of God is wherever God sovereignly takes charge or rules in human affairs. God revealed Himself progressively to the Jews in two primary ways.

He revealed Himself as creator God by what are called His eloistic names because they start with El meaning the strong, mighty one or creator. Olah – only true God,

Elyon – Most High,

Shaddai – Almighty all sufficient One,

Roi – All seeing,

Olam - everlasting,

Gibbor – Great,

Saboath – God of hosts,

Immanu-El – the God who is with us

Secondly God revealed Himself in the Yahwe or Jehovistic names. This name signifies that God is both a covenant making and covenant keeping God who has the power to save and is active in covenantal power. He was revealed as a savior / redeemer.

This name is used about 6000 times in scripture of God with a variety of compounds added to Jehovah.

Jireh - provider,

Rapha – healer,

Nissi - my banner,

Kanna – jealous,

Mekaddeskum - sanctifier,

Shalom – peace,

Shaphat – judge,

Raah – shepherd,

Tsidkenu – righteousness, Shammah – everpresent

The awe inspiring creator / redeemer had a purpose for them as a nation and as individuals.
