v5 Holy Spirit now governs my desires

- v6 Holy Spirit brings life and peace to my mind
- v9 Because Holy Spirit lives in me I have access to the spirit realm and am freed from the fleshly realm

v10 Our bodies may be dying but our Spirits are alive in righteousness

- v13 We have an obligation to live according to Holy Spirit
