3. Set your minds on things above

It's where Jesus is seated

Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 **Set your minds on things above**, not on earthly things. 3 For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God

3. Set your minds on things above Listen to the Holy Spirit

The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. 11 For who knows a person's thoughts except their own spirit within them? In the same way **no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God**. 12 What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, **so that we may understand what God has freely given us**. 13 This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit,

explaining spiritual realities with Spirit-taught words. 14 The person without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God but considers them foolishness, and cannot understand them because **they are discerned only through the Spirit**. 15 The person with the Spirit makes judgments about all things, but such a person is not subject to merely human judgments, 16 for,"Who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?" But we have the mind of Christ.
