What Unbelief Unlocks...

Unbelief:

**Blinds us to Kingdom
power even if it's in our
midst.**

“Even after Jesus had performed
so many signs in their presence,
**they still would not believe in
him.”**

John 12:37 NIV

Unbelief:

Unlocks a double mindedness. It causes us to waiver.

“Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead—since he was about a hundred years old—and that Sarah’s womb was also dead. **Yet he did not waver through unbelief** regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God,”

Romans 4:19-20 NIV

Unbelief:

Creates obstacles to the miraculous.

“He **could not do any miracles there**, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. He was amazed at their lack of faith. Then Jesus went around teaching from village to village.”

Mark 6:5-6 NIV

Unbelief:

**Stops us from seeing
heavens perspective.**

“I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; **how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things?**”

John 3:12 NIV

Unbelief:

**Unlocks bitterness and
division.**

“But the Jews who refused to believe **stirred up the other Gentiles and poisoned (embittered) their minds** against the brothers.”

Acts 14:2 NIV

Unbelief:

**Corrupts our thinking
and defiles our
conscience.**

“To the pure, all things are pure,
but to those who are corrupted
and **do not believe, nothing is
pure.** In fact, both their minds
and consciences are corrupted.”

Titus 1:15 NIV

Unbelief:

Unlocks arrogance and rebellion.

“But they, our ancestors, **became arrogant and stiff-necked**, and they did not obey your commands. They **refused to listen** and failed to remember the miracles you performed among them. They became **stiff-necked** and **in their rebellion** appointed a leader in order to return to their slavery. But you are a forgiving God, gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love. Therefore you did not desert them.”

Nehemiah 9:16-17 NIV

Faith:
Unlocks healing.

“Then the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell at his feet and, trembling with fear, told him the whole truth. He said to her, “Daughter, **your faith has healed you**. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering.”

Faith:

**Unlocks authority to
move the immovable.**

“Truly I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, ‘Go, throw yourself into the sea,’ and does not doubt in their heart but **believes** that what they say will happen, **it will be done for them.**”

Faith:

**Unlocks forgiveness
that Jesus paid for.**

“When Jesus **saw their faith**, he said, “Friend, **your sins are forgiven.**”

Luke 5:20

Faith:

Unlocks authority to resist the devil.

“Be alert and of sober mind. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

Resist him, standing firm in the faith, because you know that the family of believers throughout the world is undergoing the same kind of sufferings.”

Faith:
Unlocks encouragement.

“I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong— that is, that you and I may be **mutually encouraged by each other’s faith.**”

**Unlocks the way to
freely approach our
Heavenly Father.**

“In Whom, **because of our faith in Him**, we dare to **have the boldness** (courage and confidence) of free access (an unreserved approach to God with freedom and without fear).”

**Unlocks the shielding
power of God.**

“In addition to all this, take up **the shield of faith**, with which you can **extinguish all the flaming arrows** of the evil one.”

Faith:

In Jesus, unlocks our destiny. Our salvation is unlocked by faith.

“By faith he (Moses) left Egypt,
not fearing the king’s anger; he
persevered because he saw him
who is invisible.”

because anyone who comes to
him must believe that he exists
and that he rewards those who
earnestly seek him.”


Activating Our Key of Faith...
