
Reckless words are like the thrusts of a sword, cutting remarks meant to stab and to hurt. But the words of the wise soothe and heal.

1 CORINTHIANS 14:1-4 TPT






**EAGERLY DESIRE TO
PROPHESY**




Follow the way of love and **eagerly desire** spiritual gifts,

1 CORINTHIANS 14:4, 12



“In the last days, God says, I will pour out my **Spirit on all people**. Your sons and daughters will **prophecy**.

ACTS 2:17

5 I would like **every one of you** to speak in tongues, but I would rather have you **prophecy** . . . 29 Two or three prophets should speak, and the others should weigh carefully what is said. 30 And if a revelation comes to someone who is sitting down, the first speaker should stop. 31 For **you can all prophecy in turn** so that everyone may be instructed and encouraged.

Therefore, my brothers, **be eager to prophesy**, and do not forbid speaking in tongues.



SHOULD BE JUDGED**




20 Do not treat prophecies with contempt 21 but **test them all;**

HOW TO JUDGE EVERY PROPHECY

1. Does this prophecy edify, exhort, comfort and supply courage to stand or fight?
2. Does it conform to scripture?
3. Does this prophet and the prophecy glorify Jesus and represent Him accurately?
4. Is the prophecy free of manipulation, control or condemnation?



GIVING A PROPHECY

HOW TO GIVE A PROPHECY

1. Be passionate to serve, build up, encourage and comfort people
2. Respect the person
3. Consider the context
4. Manifest the Lord's nature
5. Let the Scriptures provide authority
