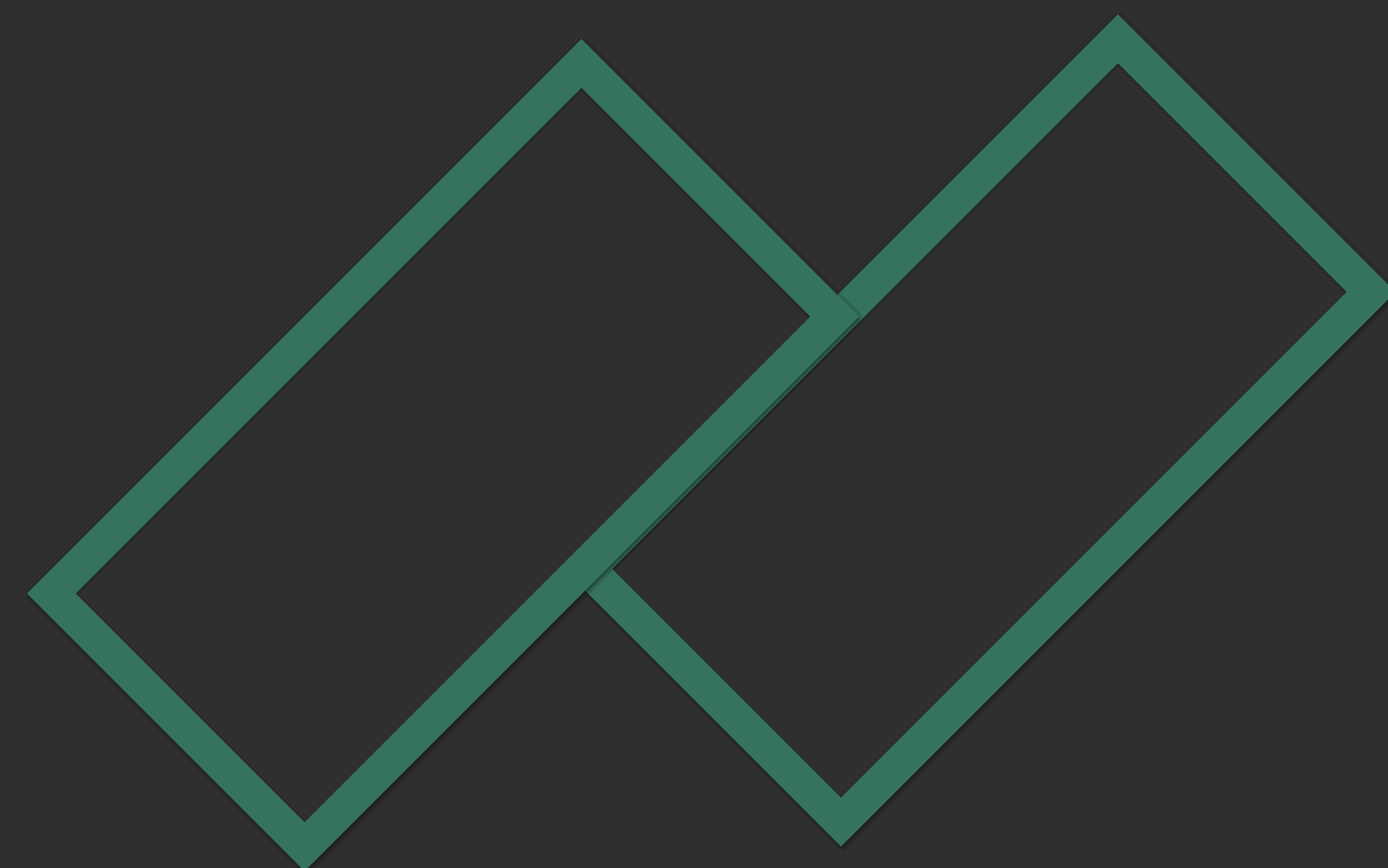
## **MATTHEW 23:37**

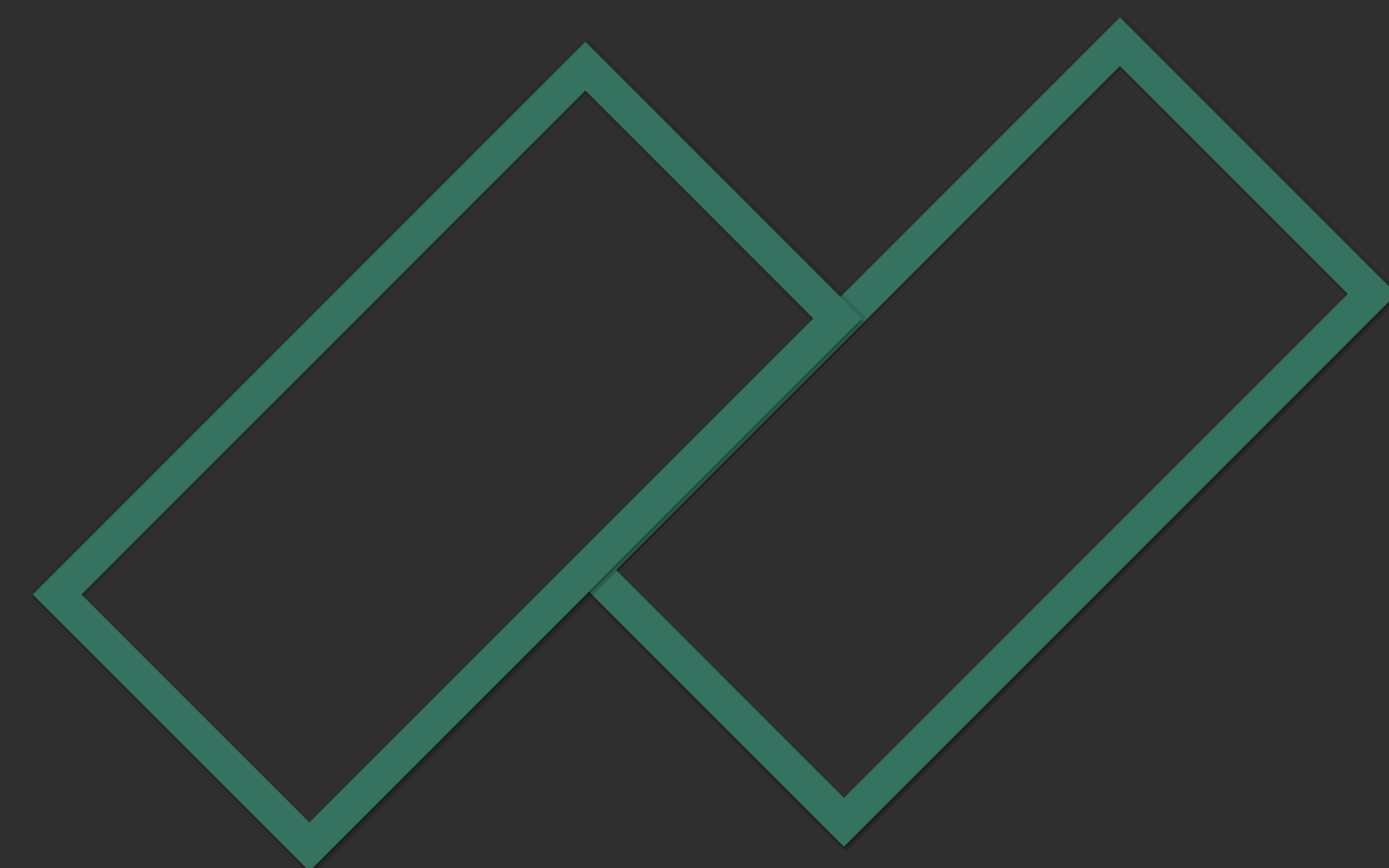
## **MATTHEW 14:12-13**

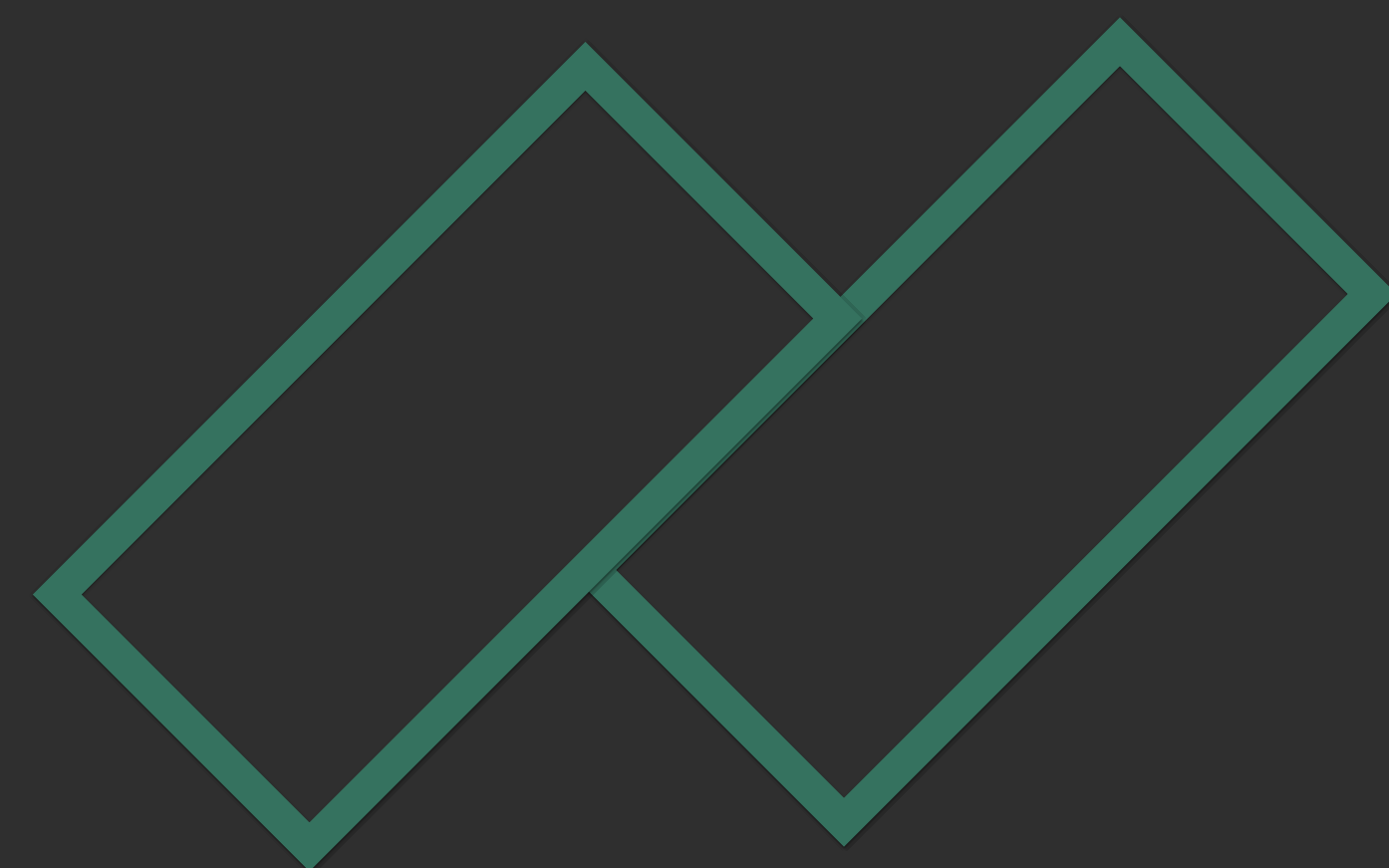
## MARK 14:32-34

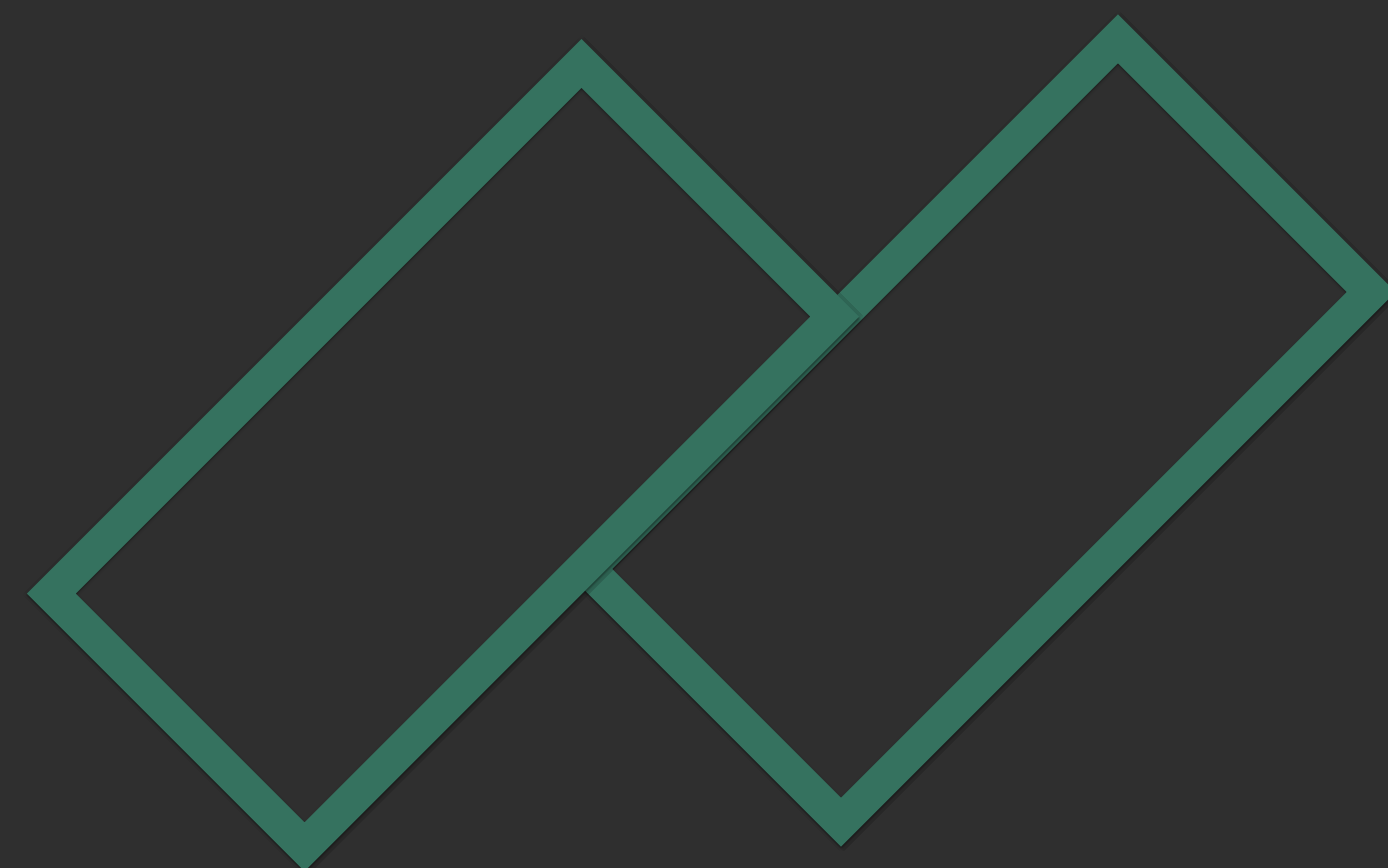

Listen to this truth: No one will enter the kingdom realm of heaven unless he becomes like one of these!""



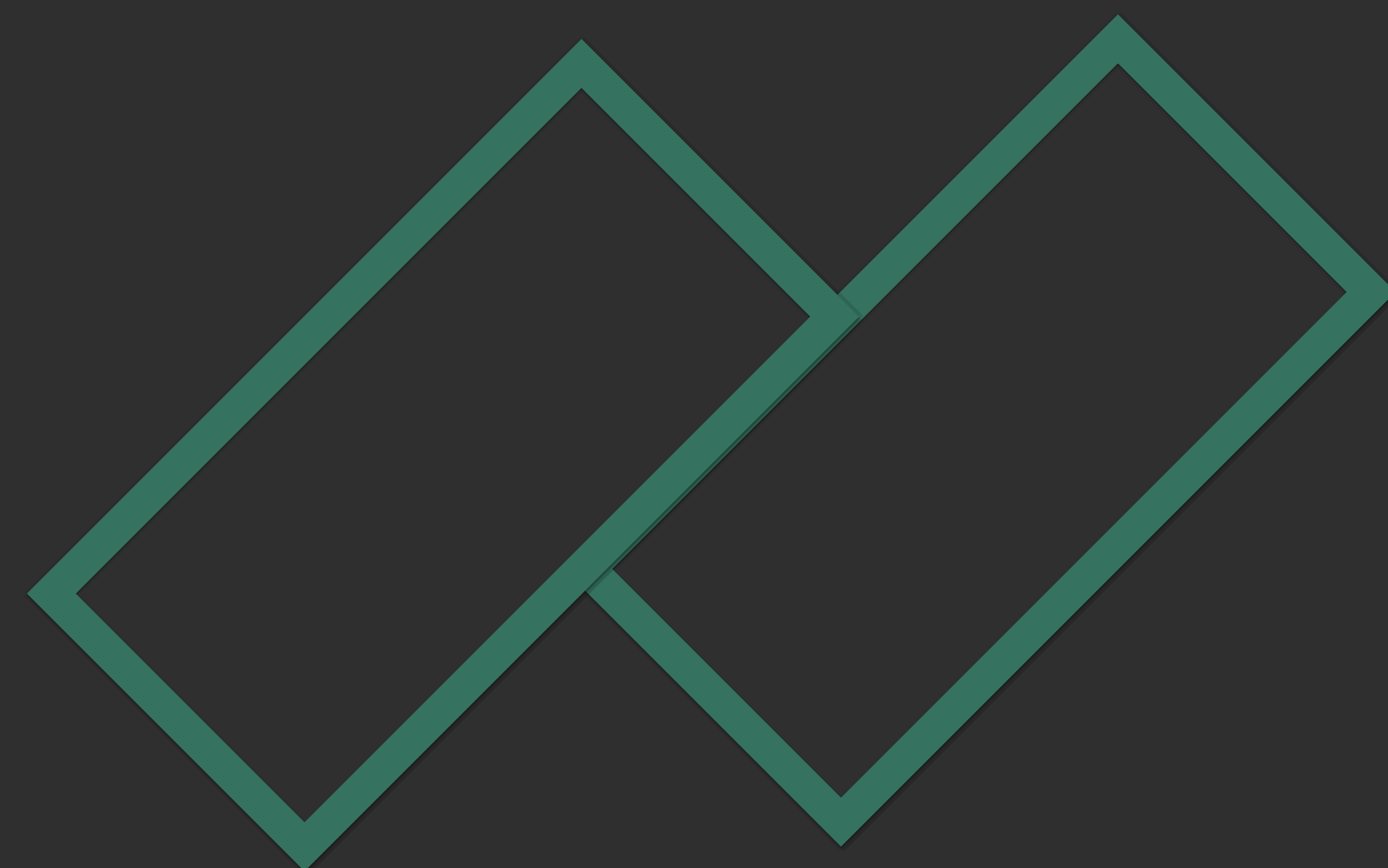
## **MATTHEW 18:6 TPT**
