

Riches of Revelation

“Wisdom”



**Not the wisdom of this world
but the Wisdom of God**



Where is the wise person? Where is the teacher of the law? Where is the philosopher of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? **For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him,** God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe.

1 Corinthians 1:20-25

Jews demand signs and Greeks look for wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified: a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles, but to those whom God has called, both Jews and Greeks, **Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God**. For the foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength.

1 Corinthians 1:20-25

We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but **not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age**, who are coming to nothing. No, **we declare God's wisdom**, a mystery that has been hidden and **that God destined for our glory before time began**. None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

1 Corinthians 2:6-10

However, as it is written: “What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived”— the things God has prepared for those who love him— **these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit.**

Who is wise and understanding among you? **Let them show it by their good life, by deeds done in the humility that comes from wisdom.** But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth. **Such "wisdom"** does not come down from heaven but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic. For where you have envy and selfish ambition, there you find disorder and every evil practice.

But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.

“Pursue Wisdom”



Then he taught me, and he said to me, Take hold of my words with all your heart; keep my commands, and you will live. **Get wisdom,** get understanding; do not forget my words or turn away from them. **Do not forsake wisdom,** and she will protect you; love her, and she will watch over you. The beginning of wisdom is this: **Get wisdom. Though it cost all you have, get understanding.** Cherish her, and she will exalt you; embrace her, and she will honor you. She will give you a garland to grace your head and present you with a glorious crown."

Proverbs 4:4-9

Does not wisdom call out? Does not understanding raise her voice? At **the highest point** along the way, **where the paths meet**, she takes her stand; **beside the gate** leading into the city, **at the entrance**, she cries aloud: "To you, O people, I call out; **I raise my voice to all mankind**. You who are simple, gain prudence; you who are foolish, set your hearts on it.

Proverbs 8:1-11

Listen, for I have trustworthy things to say; I open my lips to speak what is right. My mouth speaks what is true, for my lips detest wickedness. All the words of my mouth are just; none of them is crooked or perverse. To the discerning all of them are right; they are upright to those who have found knowledge. **Choose my instruction instead of silver, knowledge rather than choice gold, for wisdom is more precious than rubies, and nothing you desire can compare with her.**


Proverbs 8:17-21
