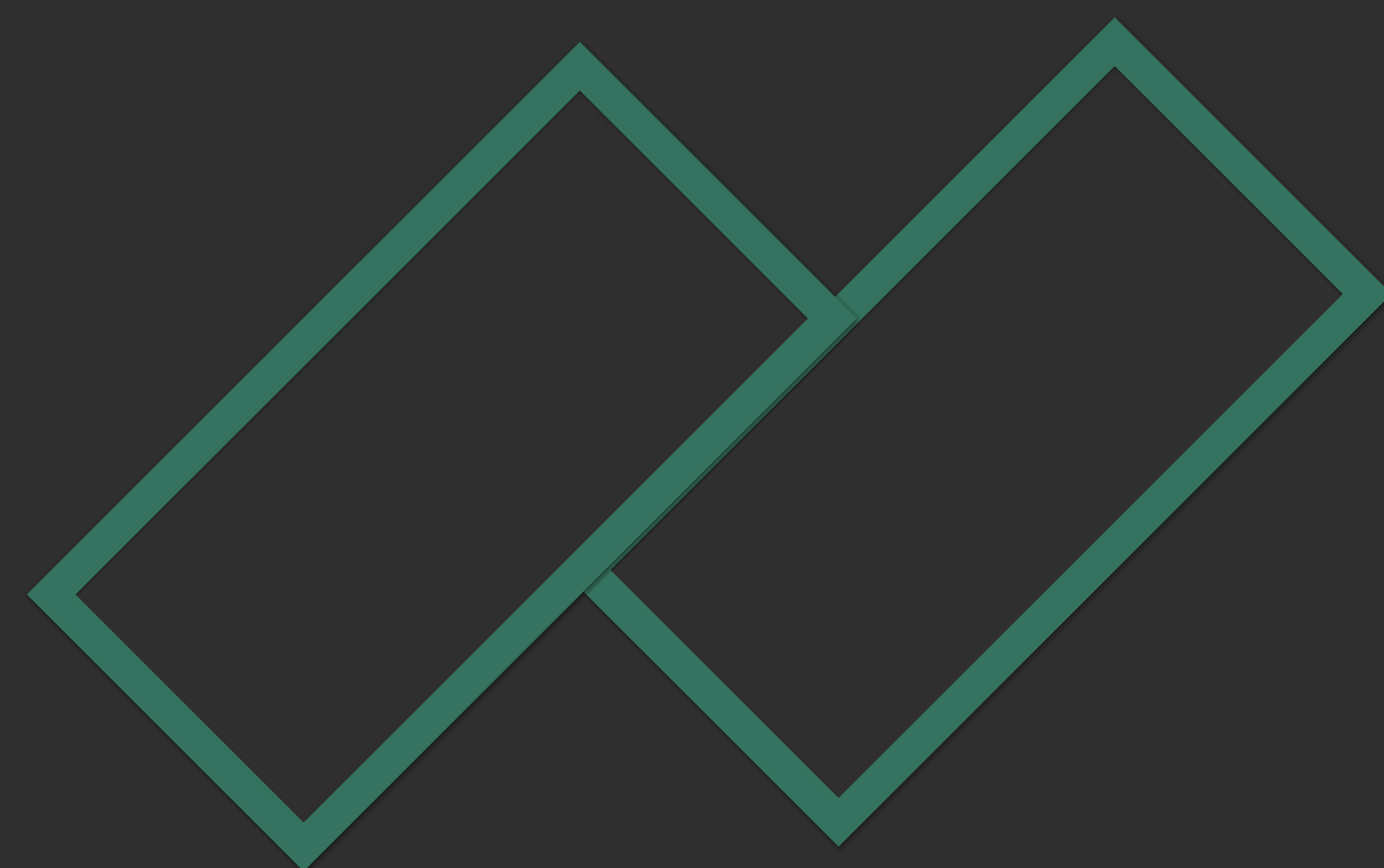


never has he changed in the love he bears to his chosen. He is "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever."
