Social isolation's adverse health consequences range from sleeplessness to reduced immune function. Loneliness is associated with higher anxiety, depression, and suicide rates. Isolation and loneliness are also linked to poor cardiovascular health and cognitive function: A study led by an epidemiologist at Newcastle University concluded that deficiencies in social relationships are associated with a higher risk for coronary heart disease and stroke.

A study published in The Journals of Gerontology concluded that Ioneliness was associated with a:

40 percent increase in the risk of dementia.

Epidemiology linked social isolation with higher risks of premature mortality.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) points to loneliness and isolation as serious public health risks.
