THE ENDLESS SACRIFICE OF REPENTANCE AND WEAK PROMISES

Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

Hebrews. 10:11

GOD IS NOT MOVED BY YOUR SACRIFICES AND WEAK PROMISES

Therefore, when Christ came into the world, he said: "Sacrifice and offering you did not desire,... with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased

Hebrews. 10:5-6

GOD IS NOT MOVED BECAUSE THESE PROMISES DO NOT WORK

The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming—not the realities themselves. For this reason it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship. Otherwise, would they not have stopped being offered? For the worshipers would have been cleansed once for all, and would no longer have felt guilty for their sins. But those sacrifices are an annual reminder of sins. It is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.

SALVATION COMES THROUGH CHRIST ALONE- NOT BY FOLLOWING THE LAW

First he said, "Sacrifices and offerings, burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not desire, nor were you pleased with them"—though they were offered in accordance with the law. Then he said, "Here I am, I have come to do your will." He sets aside the first to establish the second. And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

CHRIST SINGLE SACRIFICE PERFECT AND SUFFICIENT FOR MANKIND

But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God, waiting from that time until his enemies should be made a footstool for his feet. For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are being sanctified.
