

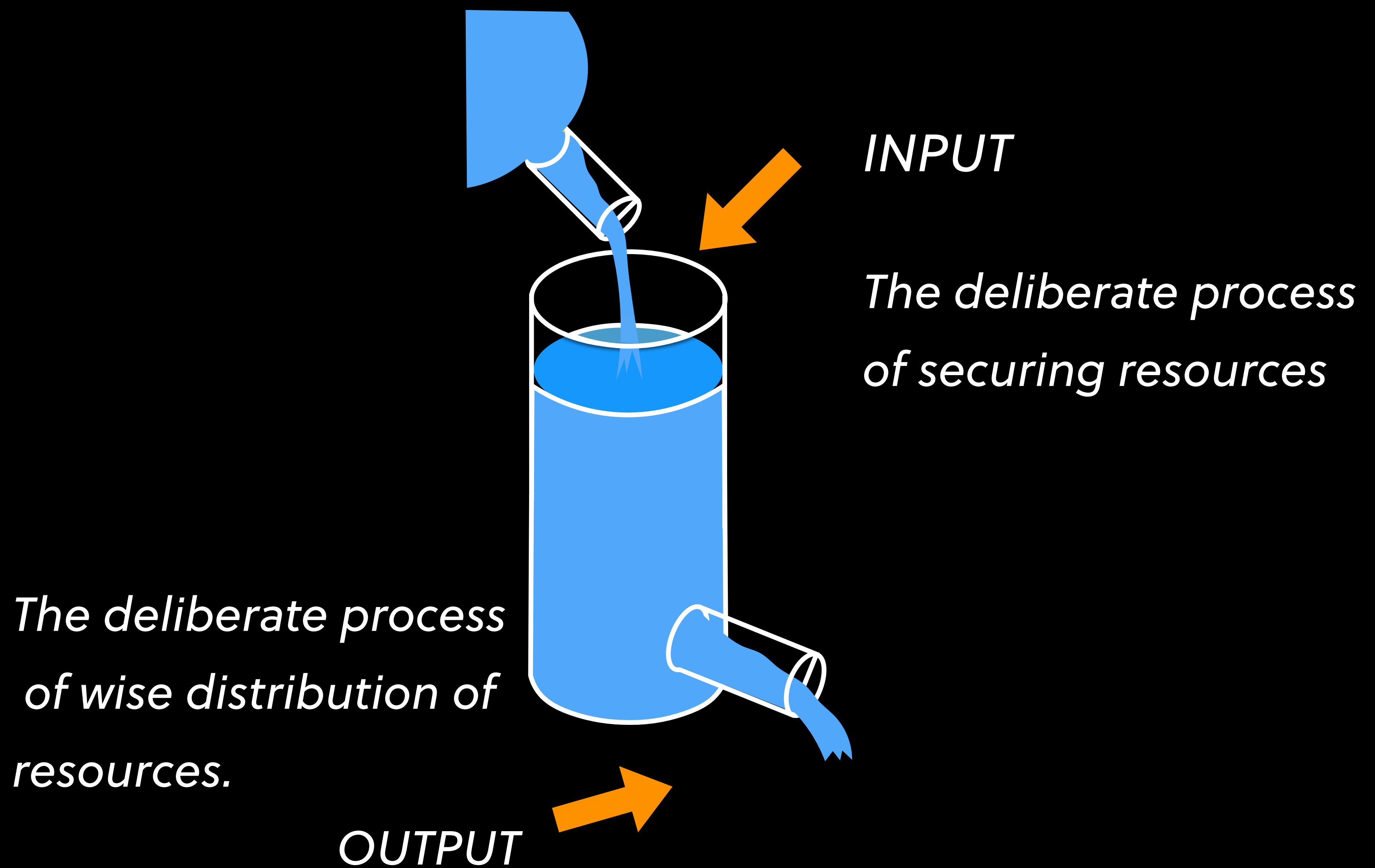
MANAGING
