**IT'S ETERNAL**

<sup>1</sup> The **law** is only a shadow of the good things that are coming— not the realities themselves. For this reason it **can never**, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, **make perfect** those who draw near to worship.

<sup>14</sup> For by one sacrifice **he has made perfect forever** those who are being made holy.

<sup>19</sup> Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have **confidence to enter** the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, <sup>20</sup> by **a new and living way** opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, <sup>21</sup> and since we have **a great priest** over the house of God, <sup>22</sup> **let us draw near to God** with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty

<sup>20</sup> That, however, is not the way of life you learned <sup>21</sup> when you heard about Christ and were taught in him in accordance with the truth that is in Jesus. <sup>22</sup> You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to **put off your old self**, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; <sup>23</sup> to **be made new** in the attitude of your minds; <sup>24</sup> and to **put on the new self**, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

<sup>9</sup> Do not lie to each other, since you **have taken off your old self** with its practices <sup>10</sup> and **have put on the new self**, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. <sup>11</sup> Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all. <sup>12</sup> Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved,

**clothe yourselves** with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. <sup>13</sup> Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone.
